America's Children

Foster Care - National Pedophile Network

A lavish three story [Victorian home in Washington, D.C.](#) equipped with audio-visual capacities and two-way mirrors were used by a national pedophile network that involved powerful people and politicians.

Children provided by foster homes and America's most favorite orphanage "Boys Town" in Omaha, Nebraska were flown across state lines and provided to pedophiles of influence and power. The children ages 11-18 years were given a plane ride to the location, money and drugs. The expression "*I'd rather own a politician than be a politician*" has a nefarious implication. But when "*a politician is photographed with a child*" he/she assumes a puppet status and can be controlled by others. Black mail is an ongoing activity.

How can a major investigation that has numerous mysterious deaths, suicides, a Who's Who roster and a seventeen year cover up continue to be so taboo that major publishing companies and media networks won't touch? Incomprehensible? No! Investigative journalist Nick Bryant spent seven years compiling data beginning with the 35 page [Leads List](#) of the legislative committee's [Special Investigator Gary Caradori](#) who died with his 9 year old son in a plane crash nineteen months after he began his investigation.

Nick Bryant has released new data in [The Franklin Scandal](#) – A story of Powerbrokers, Child Abuse and Betrayal and states several members of Congress and others involved are still visible within the political realm. An active resurgence in investigating this case has occurred since Bryant's research.

During the time Australian cult leader Anne Hamilton-Byrne was arrested in New York in 1993, a British TV network called "*Yorkshire Television*" learned of the pedophile scandal and sent a crew to Omaha to film a child trafficking documentary for Discovery Channel to be aired on May 3, 1994.

The documentary included interviews with former [CIA director William Colby](#) and several Nebraska legislators including John DeCamp who was close to the investigation and eventually represented several of the child victims. However, just days before the documentary was to air, it was deleted from the program schedule.

John DeCamp was a highly decorated Vietnam War veteran who initiated Operation Baby Lift, whereby, 2,800 orphaned Vietnamese children were evacuated. He was considered Nebraska's most effective

legislators during his 16 years in office. DeCamp presently practices law in Lincoln, Nebraska and authored the book ["Franklin Cover Up"](#).

The phrase 'follow the money' once again lead to revealing the pedophile network with the key player [Lawrence E. King, Jr.](#)

Lawrence E. King, Jr. became manager of Franklin Community Federal Credit Union in Omaha, Nebraska and solicited commercial business from Omaha's affluent in hopes of saving the failing bank. One of the most valuable accounts held was that of "Boys Town" which had a cash reserve of \$500 million.

King would hire some of the Boys Town orphans to work for his companies and eventually incorporated them into sordid activities of sex and drug orgies provided to his affluent clients. Although people were aware that [King was involved](#) in such despicable activities, no action was taken until King drew attention to himself when [his embezzlement](#) of \$39.4 million dollars from the Franklin Community Federal Credit Union was discovered. Nebraska Senator Ernie Chambers stated that King's involvement was "just the tip of an iceberg, and he's not in it by himself."

Per Bryant's research: Supreme Court Justice Clarence Thomas, then Chairman of the Equal Opportunity Commission, [described King](#) as a "friendly person," and said his legal travails were "unfortunate."

Pulitzer Prize nominee, Paul Rodriguez, [wrote an article](#) in June 1989 for the Washington Times. Ted Gunderson, former FBI special agent of the Los Angeles Division that included a budget of \$22.5 mil and 700 personnel and having 54 plus years of investigative experience, gave a [speech](#) to Congress on Child Protection, March 13, 2004. It involved the kidnappings and the auctioning of children for pedophiles. Ted Gunderson Quote:

"I developed information from a credible source in a major city in Southwest U.S. that there is collusion between judges, attorneys and underworld criminals. Children in the system, are adopted, four thousand dollars is given to the people who adopt, and the children's names are changed and each child is re-adopted up to 75 times, with four thousand dollars going to each adoption every time. The Federal Government Adoption Bonus is given to these judges, attorneys and underworld criminals it is split among the three groups of child traffickers . . .

As an outgrowth of my involvement in the Franklin Cover Up Case from Omaha, I learned that a covert CIA operation known as the Finders based in Washington D.C. which was actively involved in kidnapping and international trafficking of children since the early 1960's. This matter was brought to the attention of the FBI and State Department in February 1997. A report by the Metropolitan Police Department was classified "Secret" in the interest of National Security. The investigation by the FBI was closed down, however according to a US CUSTOMS investigative report, portions of which I will now read, the Finders became a CIA internal matter. I have given

this information to the FBI on seven occasions, and have demanded an investigation for the international kidnapping and trafficking of children. "

In 1982 in Iowa, a 12 year old paperboy mysteriously disappeared while delivering papers one Sunday morning. To read how his disappearance became entangled in the Franklin Cover Up, his mother Noreen Gosch has an interesting [interview](#).

Investigative reporter Nick Brandt states that the children who were victimized became damaged adults. Although some of the victims were able to survive, many became dysfunctional felons and drug addicts and were often found in residential projects and shelters. When interviewed by investigators, the victims' credibility was destroyed...thus expected. However, there were many who still live with the vivid memories and have a story to tell.

Brandt's additional investigative research will most assuredly help investigators to get justice for some of the victims who were discarded after their sexual marketability disappeared.
